

## Privacy Policy Statement

This is Choice & Consequence®, (CC) Internet Privacy Policy Statement. Together with the Policy on Collection and Use of Personal Information, this privacy statement discloses the privacy practices for <http://www.choiceandconsequence.org>. Office phone: 360-422-5704.

### Collection and Use of Personal Information

CC is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. We will not sell, share, or rent this information to others in ways other than those outlined in this statement. We may collect information from our users at several different points on our Web site. Personal information which identifies a specific individual will not be disclosed to others without the user's permission. If you donate to CC through the web site using a credit or debit card, the transaction is completed at the secure PayPal & GuideStar locations and the information is never on or stored on the CC site. If you wish for your donation to be anonymous, please specify this at the PayPal and GuideStar sites using the donation form provided there. Your donation will come to CC as an "anonymous" donation. If you wish to write a check to make a donation, and you wish it to be anonymous, please specify this at the bottom of your check. It will be posted as an anonymous donation on the CC donation web page.

### Feedback Form

From time to time CC may post a feedback form on the site. It is optional for a user to complete a feedback form. If a user chooses to complete one, a user is required to give certain information (such as name and email address). This information is used to contact the user about the services on our site for which they have expressed interest only if the user has requested a response.

### Sharing

CC may share only **aggregate** information with our partners and grantors, such as survey results. This aggregate information does not contain personally identifiable information and therefore cannot identify any specific individual.

### Links

This Web site contains links to other sites. Please be aware that CC is not responsible for the privacy practices of such sites. We encourage our users to be aware when they leave our site and to read the privacy statements of every Web site that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by the CC organization.

### Surveys

The CC web site may request information from users via surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary and the user therefore has a choice whether or not to disclose this information. Information requested may include demographic information (such as school attended, ethnic background and age). No other personally identifying information will be collected. Survey information will be used for purposes of improving our services and evaluating TRIS effectiveness.

### Security

This Web site takes every precaution to protect our users' information. Web donations are set up at secure sites through only PayPal and GuideStar. Users should read the privacy policy at both sites to see if and how information is used. All of our users' information is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (e.g., our Finance department) are granted access to personally identifiable information.
