Dear Parents,

The Choice & Consequence™ (CC) organization is proud to be a part of a unique health education program, “The Real Inside Story™”(TRIS), which will be coming to _____ on _____. During the presentation your child will be taken on a fantastic voyage through the human body.

The goal of this presentation is to educate young people about the importance of making positive choices. Actual human organs will be shown; some healthy, others damaged by alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use. This allows the student to see and feel first hand what can happen to their bodies when they choose habits and lifestyles that are harmful. At the end of the presentation, participants will be allowed to put on non-latex nitrile gloves and examine the organs for themselves, if time allows. All of the organs are stored in a mixture of isopropyl alcohol and water to ensure that they are safe for children to handle. TRIS nurses discuss bullying, the importance of compassion and much more! The majority of children don’t use alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs. It is not a “rite of passage”. The presentation does not address sexual or gender identity issues.

Our registered nurses, Kathy Ketchum, RN and Colleen Williams, RN present this empowering education program to schools, community groups, corporations, and professional organizations throughout Washington State and beyond. Since 1989, CC nurses have spoken to over 325,000 students! **After experiencing TRIS, many students want to share what they learned with family and friends.
